



Datganiad Grant Amddifadedd Ysgolion - YSGOL GYNRADD ABERAERON

Dyrennir y Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion (GAD) i ysgolion â disgyblion sy'n dod o deuluoedd incwm isel ac y gwyddys eu bod ar hyn o bryd yn gymwys i dderbyn prydau Ysgol am ddim (h-PYDd) a disgyblion sydd wedi 'derbyn gofal' yn barhaus am fwy na chew mis (Plant Mewn Gofal).

Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau Ysgol am ddim neu sy'n PMG.

Fel Ysgol rydym wedi cytuno ar y tri cham a ganlyn:

1. Nodi'r grwpiau targed o ddisgyblion, eu nodweddion a'u hanghenion dysgu
2. Cynllunio ymyraethau sy'n gwneud y defnydd mwyaf effeithiol o adnoddau
3. Monitor a gwerthuso effaith yr adnoddau

Yn 2017-2018, darparwyd i Ysgol Gynradd Aberaeron ddyraniad Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion o £18,050 Yn Ysgol Gynradd Aberaeron mae gennym gynllun cynhwysfawr, sydd wedi'i gytuno a'i fonitro gan Awdurdod Lleol Ceredigion ac ERW, i hyrwyddo cynnydd a lleihau effaith rhwystrau i ddysgu i fyfyrwyr sy'n gymwys ar gyfer y cyllid hwn.

Rydym wedi defnyddio'r cyllid sydd ar gael i :

- Wella dysgu ac addysgu drwy ddarparu amrywiol raglenni cefnogi
- Darparu rhaglenni ymyraeth a chymorth cynaliadwy y profwyd eu bod yn cael yr effaith fwyaf e.e. Dyfal Donc, Satpin, Trandep, Cyfri Ceredigion
- Darparu hyfforddiant penodol o safon uchel i staff, gan ganolbwyntio ar lythrennedd a rhifedd a chau'r bwch.
- Mireinio systemau olrhain data i nodi anghenion dysgwyr y grwpiau hyn, tracio eu cynnydd tuag at dargedu, ac i fonitro effaith ymyraethau yn effeithiol;
- Gweithio mewn partneriaeth ag ysgolion eraill, y gymuned a sefydliadau eraill e.e Gwasanethau Cymdeithasol, Tim o amgylch y teulu a Ysgol Gyfun Aberaeron.
- Gwella presenoldeb y grwpiau targed
- Cefnogi dysgwyr a'u teuluoedd drwy gynnig nosweithiau addysgol.
- Datblygu capasiti arweinyddiaeth i adnabod a gwerthuso effaith y camau hyn yn nhermau gwella ansawdd y ddarpariaeth a deilliannau y disgyblion yn y grwpiau targed, ac i ymyrryd yn effeithiol ac yn amserol pan mae'r cynnydd yn annigonol.
- Cynnig gostyngiad o 25% ar bob ymweliad ysgol, gwersi cerddorol a gwisg ysgol



Ysgol Gynradd Aberaeron - PDG Statement

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is allocated to schools with pupils who come from low-income families and are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (e-FSM) and pupils who have been looked after continuously for more than six months (LAC).

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will quickly bring about changes for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC.

As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

- to identify the target group of pupils, its characteristics and needs
- to plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources
- to monitor and evaluate the impact of resources

In 2015-16 Ysgol Gynradd Aberaeron was provided with a PDG allocation of £18,050.

At Ysgol Gynradd Aberaeron we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Ceredigion Local Authority and ERW, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding.

We have used the funding available to:

- enhance teaching and learning by providing various programmes of support
- provide intervention and support programmes that are proven to have the greatest impact and to be sustainable- Catch Up, Dyfal Donc, Satpin,Trandep, Cyfri Ceredigion
- provide specific high quality training for school staff based on Numeracy and Literacy
- implement and use data tracking systems to identify learners' needs, target interventions and monitor impact
- provide educational evenings for parents
- work in partnership with other schools, the community and other organisations e.g. Social Services and the Secondary School
- Developed leadership capacity to prioritise the impact on the quality of provision and outcomes
- Provide a discount of 25% on all school visits and music tuition and School Uniform
